Final Tanks Rolled Out In Rebate Scheme

More than 30,000 South Australians have to date made use of SA Water's Stand Alone Rainwater Tank Rebate Scheme, which will end on 31 March 2014.

Since the scheme was launched on 11 March 2011, SA Water has provided rebates of up to \$200 to residents who have purchased a rainwater tank of 1000Lt or greater.

The scheme is available to SA Water and non SA Water customers in both new and existing homes, but is limited to one rebate per residential property.

Those wishing to take advantage of the rebate must purchase their tank by 31 March and submit their claim by 30 June 2014.

Stand Alone Rainwater Tank Rebate Scheme Facts

- Around 500 rebate applications per month have been lodged this financial year.
- A \$9.47 million fund was created to cover the Stand Alone Rainwater Tank Rebate Scheme in 2011.
- By late January 2014, 32,374 rebates had been paid with a total value of \$6,473,845. Any unspent funds from the scheme will be returned to the Government.
- The Stand Alone Rainwater Tank Rebate is the last remaining water-saving rebate under the H₂OME Rebate Scheme, which was introduced in June 2003.
